Understanding our proposals



Consultation brochure

Map Books 1 and 2

Map Book 1 shows our draft Order limits (the land needed for the project) and information about temporary and permanent land use. Map Book 2 presents plans and profile views of the river water conveyance tunnel and the raw water conveyance pipeline.

The Draft CoCP, which is Appendix 4.3 of the PEIR, provides information about the management of environmental effects during the construction period.



PEIR Non-Technical Summary (NTS)

The Non-Technical Summary (NTS) of the PEIR provides summaries for each of the assessed aspect areas.
