The risk of severe droughts is increasing, so it's vital that we plan for future water shortages in London.

Teddington Direct River Abstraction (TDRA) is a key part of our plan to secure water supplies for the future. During droughts, it would supply up to 75 million extra litres of water per day for London – enough for over 500,000 people. It would help taps continue to flow, businesses and schools to remain open, and daily life to go on as usual.

Since our statutory consultation in 2025, we've been reviewing the feedback we received, as well as having further discussions with our key stakeholders and carrying out further design development. As a result, we've made changes to the project and now we want to hear your views on our updated proposals, before we submit our application for development consent early next year.
